

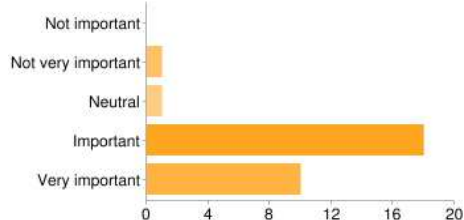

1. Have you watched the webcast or did you come to the debate?

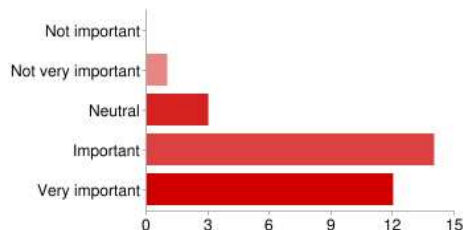
Watched the webcast (on the day or afterwards)	8	27%

2. How important for you were the topics discussed tonight? - Good cities have a thriving heart (Steve Melia, UWE)



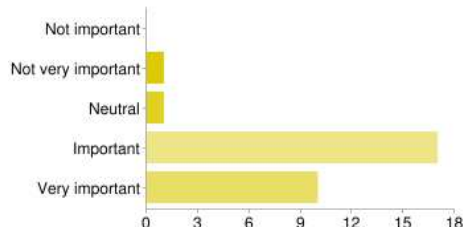

3. How important for you were the topics discussed tonight? - Transport behaviour (Sarah Toy)



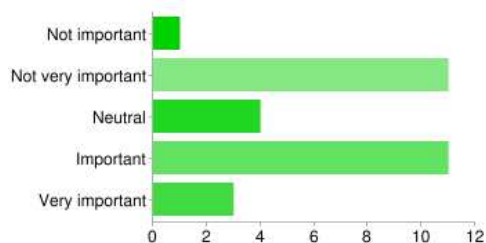

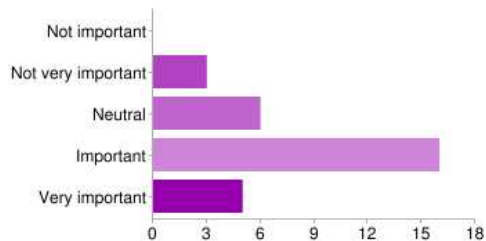

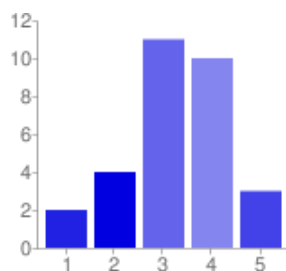

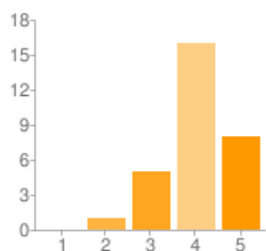

7. Do you feel that you have learnt something new at this event?



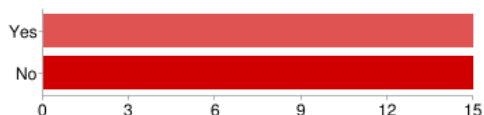
