Green Mingles

The Partnership's monthly informal networking event offers an opportunity to engage with a thriving environmental sustainability community – making connections, sharing ideas and identifying new business opportunities. Our regular attendance is between 70 - 100 people from across different sectors and industry areas.

These are generally held at [The Station Kitchen in Broadmead](#), but we have hosted Mingles at alternative venues, such as Triodos Foundation and We the Curious, for special occasions. We are always open to new and creative ideas to help our Partnership members and others to connect and collaborate.

Co-host a Green Mingle

- Logo placement and related information on our website, substantial pre- and post-event promotion on social media and through our membership and general newsletter mail-outs.

Exhibitors

If your organisation would like to have a presence at the Green Mingle to connect with attendees, exhibitors can benefit from:

- A stall or space as required to exhibit any relevant materials and chat to mingle attendees throughout the evening
- Recognition of your organisation on the Green Mingle website event page and in pre-event promotion, with relevant promotional links to your organisation, call-out or project.

Contributions

We are a micro non-profit community enterprise, so our co-hosts' and exhibitor contributions help us to support our members and cover the costs of organising Green Mingles. Co-hosting packages range from between £300 - £500 depending on the size of the organisation, and exhibitor packages range between £75 and £100. Do always contact us as we may consider discounts for certain circumstances or projects/initiatives.

Refreshments

Crudités, olives, hummus, chips and bread for attendees are included within this cost for events at The Station Kitchen.

For an additional cost, drinks can be provided by The Station Kitchen. The standard cost for providing drinks to attendees is £275 - based on the provision of 96 small glasses of wine (red & white) and 25 glasses of a soft drink. Organisations do have the option to provide refreshments through other suppliers, but a £150 corkage charge payable to The Station Kitchen will apply.
